

Diagnosis of *Aloe × buzairiensis* J. Lodé 2011

In the article of Cactus-Adventures n°85, January, 2010 concerning the description of the nothotaxon *Aloe × buzairiensis* from the Island of Socotra, the diagnosis was not included: here it is, thus allowing to validate the description.

Diagnosis

Planta inter *Aloe perryi* et *A. squarrosam*, ex hybridatione harum genita, characteribus ambarum, epidermis caerulescenti *A. perryi* simili maculata que *A. squarrosa* simili. Inflorescentia ejus *A. squarrosa* affinis, sed floribus rubris, caulibus robustis erectis. Crescit inter collibus in dumetis *Buxi hildebrandtii*.

Holotypus : in regione occidentale insulae Socotra (Jabal Buzairi, 764m alt.). Lecta ab Joël Lodé 26 oct 2009. (Herb. Fundación Joël Lodé n°1230512, Cuevas del Almanzora, Almería, Spain).
